- 1. Travesty of the Game [Rule 33(b)]
- 2. Goaltender Refuses to Remove Facial Protector for Identification [Rule 23(b)]
- 3. **Protective Equipment** [Rule 24 Clarification 4]

Combatants Undo each other's Chinstrap or Remove Opponent's helmet before fight

4. Protective Equipment [Rule 24 Clarification 2]

Player undoes chinstrap to challenge or incite opponent to a fight and loses helmet during the fight.

5. **Protective Equipment** [Rule 24 Situation 11]

Player penalized for wearing non-certified mandatory protective equipment refuses to change that illegal equipment or is discovered on the ice with same illegal equipment.

6. Dangerous Equipment [Rule 25 Situation 3]

Player penalized for dangerous equipment discovered on the ice wearing/using same piece of dangerous of equipment.

- 7. Spray Water on an Official [Rule 33 Situation 3]
- 8. Discriminatory Slur / Comment [Rule 47(f)]
- 9. **Team Official Head-Butting** [Rule 49(b)]

A double Minor penalty plus a Gross Misconduct is assessed to any Team Official that head-butts or attempts to head-butt an opponent.

10. Team Official – Butt-Ending [Rule 49(f)]

A double Minor penalty plus a Gross Misconduct is assessed to any Team Official that attempts to butt-end an opponent.

11. **Team Official – Spearing** [Rules 49(g)]

A double Minor penalty plus a Gross Misconduct is assessed to any Team Official that pokes or jabs or attempts to poke or jab an opponent (when the severity of the action is not sufficient to attract a Match penalty for attempt to injure)

- 12. Player or Team Official Fighting with a Team Official [Rule 59(d)]
- 13. **Fighting with Spectator** [Rule 59 Situation 17]
