- Issue full or part-mark downgrades
- Issue part marks if some mandatory components of an answer are not provided. However, if the final penalty / on-ice strength outcome is not correct due to a missing or extra penalty, mark the answer wrong
- Items considered "optional" are enclosed in brackets of this style: [ ]
- Do not downgrade if an optional response is not included in the answer
- If an optional response or any extra information provided is incorrect, consider a part or full mark downgrade depending on the criticality of the error. If the solution results in the wrong number of players on the ice, or a wrong player being ruled off the ice, or a wrong player being allowed to remain in the game = no part marks.

ANSWER KEY

1. [Rule 1.9(c)] Five
2. [Rule 2.5(h)] Bench Minor [\* Served by one of the offending players]
3. [Equipment Measurement Guideline #2 & Situation #1; Rule 3.5(c); Rule 3.5 Situations 1 & 2]
  - Measurement to take place in the Referee's crease
  - Goaltender is allowed 4 hits on each pad before the measurement
  - Measurement taken with goaltender standing and pads not contacting a fixed object
  - Both pads are to be measured at their widest point
  - If the pads are illegal: Minor penalty (illegal equipment)
  - If the pads are legal: Bench Minor [\* for unsustained measurement request] to team that requested the measurement
  - Measurement result is to be demonstrated to the captain of the team that receives the penalty
4. [Rule Book, Section 3 – Equipment Measurement Guidelines] No.

5. [Rule 3.2(a)] No.
6. [Rule 3.2 Situation 1] Minor to A8 [\* for illegally receiving a stick. \* No penalty to A6.]
7. [Rule 3.2 Situation 2] **Note to Markers: Do not issue part marks for this question.**
- Bench Minor + Game Misconduct [for interference to the person identified as having thrown the stick]
  - Minor [illegally receiving a stick to A6]
8. [Rule 4.9 Situation 2] Puck
9. [Rule 4.2 Situation 9] A9
10. [Rule 4.2 Situation 10] A9
11. [Rule 4.2 Situation 17] Player serving B14's [\* time] penalties
12. [Rule 4.2 Situation 19] B8 remains in penalty box until 1<sup>st</sup> stoppage after 3:00
13. [Rule 4.4 Situation 10]
- A3 remains in penalty box until 1<sup>st</sup> stoppage after his [non-time] penalty expires
  - B7 remains in penalty box until 1<sup>st</sup> stoppage after his [non-time] penalty expires
  - B8 serves a 2-minute time penalty
  - [A6, A9, B11 & B12 are ejected from the game]
  - Play resumes with Team A at full strength and Team B one player short [\* shorthanded]
14. [Rule 4.9 Situation 1] **Note to Markers: Each element is worth ¼ mark.**
- Deliberately knocking the goal from its moorings
  - Deliberately removing a helmet or facial protector
  - Refusing to start play
  - Deliberate illegal substitution

15. [Rule 4.9 Situation 2] **Note to Markers: Each element is worth ¼ mark.**
- Puck must be in the neutral or attacking zone
  - [Fouled] player must have control [of the puck]
  - [Fouled] player must be on a breakaway [no one between him and the goaltender]
  - [Fouled] player must denied a reasonable scoring opportunity
16. [Rule 4.10 Situation 5] **Note to Markers: Each element is worth ½ mark.**
- If puck is in Team A's defending zone when stick arrives: Penalty Shot
  - If puck is NOT in Team A's defending zone: Minor penalty [for throwing a stick]
17. [Rule 4.12(b) & (c)] **Note to Markers: Do not issue part marks for this question.**  
A12 @ 2:50; A10 @ 7:30; A4 @ 7:00
18. [Rule 4.13(a)] Stop play immediately when the foul occurs
19. [Rule 4.13 Situation 9] Minor [Spearing]
20. [Rule 6.1(b) and Rule 6.5(a)] Double Minor [Head Butting or Head Contact]
21. [Rule 6.1 Situations 2, 3 & 4] NO penalty or Match or Gross Misconduct. Report to President
22. [Rule 6.3(a)] Major + GM
23. [Rule 6.3(b)] Major + GM
24. [Rule 6.4(b)] Match
25. [Rule 6.4(a)] Cancel the Minor. Assess e GM
26. [Rule 6.5(a)] **Note to Markers: Do not issue part marks for this question.**
- Minor
  - Double Minor
  - Major + GM

27. [Rule 6.5(b)] **Note to Markers: Do not issue part marks for this question.**
- Minor + Misconduct
  - Major + GM
28. [Rule 6.6(a)] Yes
29. [Rule 6.7 Situation 4] Major + Game Misconduct [fighting] + Minor [aggressor]
30. [Rule 6.7 Situation 12] Minor [leaving crease during a fight]
31. [Rule 6.7 Situation 19] **Note to Markers: Do not award part marks for this question**
- Major + Game Misconduct [fight] to all players including goaltenders
  - Game Misconduct [2<sup>nd</sup> fight same stoppage] to all but the first pair of combatants
  - Minor to both goaltenders [leaving crease during a fight]
32. [Rule 6.7 Situation 20] **Note to Markers: Make ½ mark deduction if B7's Minor is listed and is for "instigator"**
- A3: Minor [roughing]
  - B7: Major + GM [fighting] plus Minor [aggressor]
33. [Rule 6.7 Situation 21] Major + GM [fighting] +& Minor [aggressor]
34. [Rule 7.3(f)] No penalty
35. [Rule 7.2(a) & (b)] **Note to Markers: Each element is worth half-marks. Also, deduct ½ mark if penalty is assessed for Butt-End Hooking.**
- Minor [or, if injury occurs,] Major + GM [hooking]
36. [Rule 7.3(c) & (d)] **Note to Markers: Each element is worth ½ mark.**
- Offender identified: Bench Minor + GM
  - Offender NOT identified: Bench Minor
37. [Rule 7.4 Situation 2] Minor [or at Referee's discretion, Major + GM (Hooking)]
38. [Rule 8.1(b)] Major + Game Misconduct

39. [Rule 8.1(c)] Major + GM [Cross-checking]
40. [Rule 8.2 Situation 9] Disallow the goal. Face-off at the nearest neutral zone face-off spot.
41. [Rule 9.5 Situation 12 Example A] **Note to Markers: Do not issue part marks for this question.**
- Allow the goal
  - A3 returns to the penalty bench to serve the time remaining in the penalty when she left the penalty bench
42. [Rule 9.1 Situation 2] Immediate whistle. [Face-off at the nearest neutral zone face-off spot]
43. [Rule 9.2(c)] Bench Minor
44. [Rule 9.5(b)&(c) + Situations 8 & 10] Team A: Six Team B: Five
45. [Rule 9.5 Situation 3] **Note to Markers: Do not issue part marks for this question.**
- Cancel A3's Minor in progress
  - Assess A3: Minor [leaving penalty bench before penalty expires] plus penalty [Minor/Major/Match] for the foul from behind
46. [Rule 9.8 Situation 7] Minor [throwing stick]
47. [Rule 10.1 Situation 2] B
48. [Rule 10.1 Situation 5] **Note to Markers: Each element is worth ½ mark.**
- Minor [delay of game]
  - Penalty Shot [in lieu of Minor] if foul occurs during the last 2 minutes of regular playing time or at any time in overtime
49. [Rule 10.3 Situation 3 Point 4 and Rule 10.1(e)] Minor [Delay of Game or Falling on the Puck]
50. [Rule 10.7] Disallow the goal. Face-off at the nearest neutral zone face-off spot
