1. A gathering occurs. While the gathering is in progress, Banfield leaves the players' bench. Subsequently, Oakman (Banfield's teammate) leaves the penalty bench on his own accord before his Minor penalty expires. SRD.

**Banfield: No penalty**

**Oakman: Minor (leaving penalty bench prior to expiration of penalty)**

2. Crawford has been taunted all game by a spectator behind his players' bench. After receiving his second "barley shower" from this fan, Crawford turns around and punches the fan twice in the nose before he is restrained by his team-mates. SRD if it is felt that the fan instigated the incident. SRD if it is felt that Crawford instigated the incident.

**If fan instigated: No penalty to Crawford**

**If Crawford instigated: Gross Misconduct (travesty of the game). Note: Match (attempt to injure) may be assessed in lieu of Gross**

3. Satvir and Lowe decide to "go". Both of these ladies skate to centre ice, drop their gloves and "shadow box" (no punches thrown, just a lot of jockeying for position). While this is going on the referee instructs all the other players to go to their bench, which they do. Eventually, and simultaneously, Satvir and Lowe throw one roundhouse type punch each. Lowe connects; Satvir misses. Satvir goes down, out cold! Lowe bows to the crowd, dusts off her hands and leaves the ice without further incident. SRD.

**Both: Major + Game Misconduct (fighting)**

4. Player Titus is fuming mad and is serving a Minor penalty. At a stoppage of play, before his penalty expires, Titus leaves the penalty box of his own accord and knocks Luxmore to the ground with a single blind-side punch. SRD. Penalties assessed? Who serves? How long?

**Luxmore: No penalty**

**Titus: Minor (leaving the penalty bench before penalty expired) + double Minors & Game Misconduct (leaving bench for purpose of starting a fight) + Minor (instigator) + Major & Game Misconduct (fighting)**

**A player on ice when play stopped serves 13 minutes plus time remaining in Titus' original penalty at the moment he left the penalty box**



5. Player Carnegie's team is playing shorthanded because Carnegie is serving a 5-minute time penalty incurred by a team-mate. While play is in progress, and before his penalty expires, Carnegie leaves the penalty bench of his own accord to pursue opponent Dixon who has a breakaway in the neutral zone. As Carnegie closes on Dixon he delivers a moderate intensity slash to Dixon's forearm, injuring Dixon. Dixon's team manages to score play is stopped. In your opinion, Carnegie's slash was not a deliberate attempt to injure. SRD.

Goal counts.

Carnegie: Major & Game Misconduct (slashing) and ejected from the game.

Player on the ice when play was stopped serves time remaining (at the moment Carnegie left the penalty bench) in the original 5-minute time penalty being served by Carnegie.

Another player on the ice when play was stopped serves a Carnegie's 5-minute time penalty for slashing. This time penalty starts immediately.

Carnegie's team resumes play two players short.

Editors Notes:

1. A Penalty Shot is not awarded because Dixon's team scored.
  2. The 5-minute time penalty being served by Carnegie is not cancelled by the goal because Carnegie's team was not shorthanded due to a Minor or Bench Minor penalty. However, the Minor that would normally be assessed to Carnegie for leaving the penalty bench before his penalty expired is cancelled due to the goal (Reference: Rule 4.13(b)).
6. Player Trevor, who is half way through serving a Minor penalty, leaves the penalty bench of his own accord, and participates in the play. His team scores while he is on the ice before his penalty time expires. As Trevor and his team celebrate the scoring of the goal (they do the old high fives down the line thing with all the players on the player's bench) one of the opposing team officials grabs Foster and starts pounding on him. Trevor responds in kind – a pretty good tilt ensues between these two. As the fight starts you observe one player from each team (Wallace from the home team, Traub from the visitors) jump off the players' bench onto the ice at pretty much the same instant. Luckily, you intervene before these players get too far off their bench and they turn around and exit the ice without further incident. The timekeeper advises you about Trevor's early departure from the penalty bench as you report the goal. SRD.

Disallow the goal. Face-off at the nearest neutral zone face-off spot.

Trevor: Minor (leaving the penalty bench prematurely) + Gross Misconduct (fighting with a team official).

Team Official: Bench Minor & Game Misconduct (interference) + Gross Misconduct (for creating a travesty of the game by fighting with a player).

Wallace and Traub, both get: Double Minor + Game Misconduct (first to leave the bench during a fight).

Player on the ice when play was stopped must serve the time remaining in Trevor's original Minor penalty when he left the penalty bench.



7. During a power play, player Sepe obtains a breakaway with the puck in the neutral zone. As Sepe passes the defending team player's bench someone throws a goaltender's stick from the bench at him. The stick gets caught between Sepe legs and he trips, causing him to lose control of the puck and fall awkwardly. One of Sepe's team-mates scores on the play. Sepe broke his wrist when he fell. SRD.

If penalty in progress was a Minor or Bench Minor, that penalty is washed out by the goal.

If penalty in progress was a Major or Match penalty, no penalty is washed out due to the goal.

Editor's Note: The Referee must identify the offending person. This is achieved in consultation with other on-ice officials or asking the offending team captain to identify the offender.

Offending person: Major & Game Misconduct (Interference – resulting in injury).

8. What time does each player return to the ice if the next stoppage of play is 3:30?

A4 2 min. @ 8:00

A6 2 min. @ 7:20

A8 2 min. @ 7:00

A4 @ 5:20, A6 @ 4:00, A8 @ 3:30

9. What time does each player return to the ice if the next stoppage of play is 3:30?

A4 2 min. @ 12:00

A6 5 min. @ 11:30

A8 2 min. @ 11:00

A4 @ 8:00, A6 @ 3:30, A8 @ 6:30

10. Right off the face-off, home team tough guy Marley drops his gloves and jumps visiting player Nesseth, who "turtles" without ever retaliating. A split second later, all of the remaining players on the ice drop their gloves, pair off with another opposing player and start to fight. Both goaltenders meet at centre ice and start to fight. No players leave their bench during this incident. SRD.

Nesseth: No penalties

Marley: Minor (instigator) + Major & Game Misconduct (fighting)

Both goaltenders: Major & Game Misconduct (fighting) + Game Misconduct (taking part in another fight at same stoppage) + Minor (leaving crease during fight)

All other players on the ice...each receive: Major & Game Misconduct (fighting) + Game Misconduct (taking part in another fight at same stoppage)



11. Right off the face-off, home team tough guy Marley drops his gloves and jumps visiting player Nesseth, who “turtles” without ever retaliating. A split second later, all of the remaining players on the ice drop their gloves, pair off with another opposing player and start to fight. Both goaltenders meet at centre ice and start to fight. One of the fights migrates to one of the players’ benches - Home team player Pindar (who is on the bench) grabs visiting player Mintsopoulos and holds him so that home team player Hache (who is on the ice) can “wail away”. In response to this action, visiting player Rocca leaps off the bench and fights with Hache. Mintsopoulos ends up fighting with Pindar. Both benches empty totally after Rocca leaves the bench, and a few players from the bench also end up fighting. SRD.

**Editors Note:** Recall that the Marley-Nesseth fight is the original fight.

**Home team:**

**Marley:** Minor (instigator) + Major & Game Misconduct (fighting).

**Pindar:** Bench Minor & Game Misconduct (interference from bench) + Game Misconduct (intervening in Hache-Mintsopoulos fight) + Major & Game Misconduct (fighting with Mintsopoulos) + Game Misconduct (taking part in another fight (with Mintsopoulos) at same stoppage)

**Hache:** Major & Game (fighting – original on ice) + Major & Game Misconduct (fighting with Mintsopoulos) + Major & Game Misconduct (fighting with Rocca) + Game Misconduct (taking part in another fight with Mintsopoulos at the same stoppage) + Game Misconduct (taking part in another fight with Rocca at the same stoppage).

**TWO** other home team players...each gets: Major + Game Misconduct (fighting) + Game Misconduct (taking part in another fight at the same stoppage) + (possibly, if they were from the bench) Game Misconduct (leaving bench during a fight).

**Visiting team:**

**Nesseth:** No penalty.

**Mintsopoulos:** Major & Game (fighting – original on ice) + Major & Game Misconduct (fighting with Hache) + a Game Misconduct (taking part in another fight (with Hache) at the same stoppage) + Major and Game Misconduct (fighting with Pindar) + Game Misconduct (taking part in another fight (with Pindar) at the same stoppage).

**Rocca:** Double Minors & Game Misconduct (1st to leave bench during fight) + Game Misconduct (joining in Hache-Mintsopoulos fight) + Major & Game Misconduct (fighting with Hache) + Game Misconduct (taking part in another fight (with Hache) at same stoppage).

**FOUR** other visiting team players...each gets: Major + Game Misconduct for fighting + Game Misconduct for taking part in another fight at the same stoppage + (possibly, if they were from the bench) Game Misconduct for leaving bench during a fight).
